

## Alcohol definitions

- 1 alcopop A pre-mixed alcoholic drink.
- 2 bubbly Champagne or sparkling wine.
- 3 cask A cardboard box with plastic lining and a small tap, used to hold and serve wine.
- 4 cleanskin Cheap, unbranded wine.
- 5 keg A small barrel, usually holding 20-40 litres (often beer).
- 6 light/lite Low in alcohol content.
- 7 mixer A beverage such as cola, juice, or soda water that can be combined with liquor to produce a mixed drink.
- 8 mocktail A non-alcoholic cocktail.
- 9 nip/shot A small serve of spirits.
- 10 plonk Wine (usually cheap and/or poor quality).
- 11 six-pack Half a dozen bottles or cans of beer.
- 12 slab A carton of 24 cans or bottles of beer.
- 13 spirits Undiluted distilled alcohol.
- 14 stubbie A short glass bottle for beer (330-375 ml).
