1	alcopop	A pre-mixed alcoholic drink.
2	bubbly	Champagne or sparkling wine.
3	cask	A cardboard box with plastic lining and a small tap, used to hold and serve wine.
4	cleanskin	Cheap, unbranded wine.
5	keg	A small barrel, usually holding 20-40 litres (often beer).
6	light/lite	Low in alcohol content.
7	mixer	A beverage such as cola, juice, or soda water that can be combined with liquor to produce a mixed drink.
8	mocktail	A non-alcoholic cocktail.
9	nip/shot	A small serve of spirits.
10	plonk	Wine (usually cheap and/or poor quality).
11	six-pack	Half a dozen bottles or cans of beer.
12	slab	A carton of 24 cans or bottles of beer.
13	spirits	Undiluted distilled alcohol.
14	stubbie	A short glass bottle for beer (330-375 ml).
